Permanent Action

<u>Action 1</u>. All CGMS Members to inform the Secretariat of any change in the status or plans of their satellites to allow the updating of the CGMS Tables of satellites. CGMS Members to update the table on polar-orbiting satellite equator crossing times as well as the table on coverage from geostationary satellites.

Action from CGMS XXXIII

<u>33.01</u> CGMS Members to continue interacting with WMO (Dr. Bizzarro Bizzarri) in order to resolve any doubtful or missing information to complete the next issue of the "Status of the space-based component of the global observing system" Any further updates submitted as part of Agenda items B1, B2, B3, C1, C2, and C3 should be delivered if possible at least one month in advance of CGMS-34 to allow final tuning of the report before CGMS plenary.

<u>33.11</u> CMA to provide as a matter of urgency technical and operational parameters of the planned data transmissions in the frequency band 7750-7850 MHz to CGMS Members.
