ISRO Satellite Integration and Testing Establishment (ISITE)



Established in 2006 in a 110 acre campus, ISITE is equipped with state-of-the-art clean room facilities for spacecraft integration and test facilities including a 6.5 Metre thermo vacuum chamber, 29 Ton vibration facility, Compact Antenna Test facility and acoustic test facility under one roof. Assembly, Integration and Testing of all Communication and Navigation Spacecraft is carried out at ISITE. A dedicated facility for the product ionisation of

standardised subsystems is established at ISITE.

Lalbagh Botanical Gardens



The Red Garden in English, is a well known botanical garden in southern Bengaluru, India. The garden was originally commissioned by Hyder Ali, the ruler of Mysore, and later finished by his son Tipu Sultan. It has a famous glass house which hosts two annual flower shows (26 January and 15 August). Lalbagh houses India's largest collection of tropical plants, has a lake, and is one of the main tourist attractions in Bengaluru. Lal Bagh is also home to a few species of birds. The

commonly sighted birds include Myna, Parakeets, Crows, Brahminy Kite, Pond Heron, Common Egret, Purple Moor Hen etc.

Travel to Bangalore

Kempegowda International Airport is around 40 km north of Bengaluru city and there are direct flights to Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru from Abu Dhabi, Amsterdam, Doha, Dubai, Frankfurt, Hong Kong, Kuala Lumpur, London-Heathrow, Muscat, Paris, San Francisco, Singapore.

Local Transfer

The Hotel Shangri-la is around 32 km away from the Bengaluru International Airport and takes around 1 hr by taxi.

Hotel will arrange for the pick-up of its guests <u>if specifically requested</u>. This service chargeable at the rate of INR 2700 + Taxes for one way.

By Airport Taxis

The Arrival launge will have counters for Airport Taxis (Meru Cabs, Mega Cabs and KSTDC Cabs). They are metered taxis and you can pay to the cab drivers. These taxis will charge you around INR 950 in the normal hours and around INR 1100 between 00 hrs and 6.00 am.

You can also find Akbar Travels counter in the arrival launge. The taxis hired from this counter will be costing around INR 1725 (Sedan class of vehicles) and 2025 (6/7 seater SUV class vehicle). Akbar travels can be booked in advance through www.akbarcab.com.

General Information Bengaluru, India

Tourist information

Bengaluru is the capital city of the southern Indian state of Karnataka and is 949 metres above sea level, on top of a ridge in the Karnataka plateau. It is the seventh largest city in India also known as the Garden city because of its many beautiful gardens and parks.

The city is full of beautiful, historical edifices and structures. Some of the most famous sights in Bengaluru include the Bangalore Palace, the Lal Bagh botanical garden, the Cubbon Park, the Vidhana Soudha, the highly elaborate bull temple and the Jumma Masjid.

Climate

June is the end of summer season in Bengaluru and may experience south-western monsoon rains. In the middle of June, the average temperature is around 29°C / 84°F.

Currency/Banks

The currency of the India is Rupee (INR).

There are banks and currency exchange kiosks located at the airport and near the hotel in the city. It is convenient to have the currency exchange done at Airport on your arrival.

Electricity

The voltage used in India is 230 volts with 50 Hertz. 2-round-pin and three round pins arranged in a triangle plugs are used, so please purchase a plug adapter in advance if you use 2-flat-pin or 3-flat-pin plugs.
